Public Transport

Train

Fortitude Valley Train Station is the closest to the venue and only a short walk to the festival entry on Costin Street.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Tickets & Show

- All tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.
- A search of persons and/or possessions will be required at the time of entry to the venue.
- There will be police patrols with dogs and metal detectors through out the event.
- The right is reserved to change artists and advertised programs.
- The right is reserved to refuse entry or evict patrons if they are intoxicated and/or behaving in a disorderly, offensive or inappropriate manner.
- No Pass outs.

All ages event

- ID or Proof of age must be presented if you are 18 years old and older.
- Young children must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

Prohibited Items

- Chairs of any kind, alcohol, cans, beverages in bottles (plastic bottled water with sealed cap allowed), glass, hard eskies, umbrellas, prams, weapons, laser pointers, illicit drugs, happy herbs and sharp objects are not permitted into the event site.
- Prohibited items will be confiscated, disposed or submitted to authorities as per local state law.

Other Items

- Daypacks (small) and handbags allowed (no large bags).
- No cloakroom facilities.
 - Smoking is restricted to smoking zones.

Photography

- Still cameras (not professional) are permitted but images may only be used for private purposes and not public display.
- No video cameras or professional cameras are permitted.
- Patrons offer consent to be included in film and sound recordings of the event.
- Event organisers reserve the right to publish, broadcast or telecast any part of the event.
